### Poster Sessions

13:00–14:00

### Poster Preparation

- > Each presenter is provided with a 90-centimeters-wide by 180-centimeters-high poster board, so posters must not exceed these dimensions.
- > The presentation must match the subject and contents of the submitted abstract.
- > Place the title of your paper and your paper number prominently at the top of the poster board to allow viewers to identify your paper.
- > Highlight the authors’ names and contact information in case the viewer is interested in more information.
- > Prepare diagrams or charts legibly in a size sufficient to be read at a distance of 2 meters.
- > Paragraph and figure captions should be at least in a 24-point font (0.9 cm height) and headers at least in a 36-point font (1.2 cm height). Be creative by using different font sizes, styles, and colors.
- > Organize the presentation so it is clear, orderly, and self-explanatory.
- > Include the background of your research followed by results and conclusions. A successful poster presentation depends on how well you convey information to an interested audience.

### Poster Set-Up

- > To locate your assigned poster board, look for the sign marked with your session number at the beginning of each row of posters. Each poster board will be marked with an individual presentation number. The online scientific program will be posted in the coming days. Please check back for updates to the online program.
- > Posters should be set up between 8:00 and 11:00 on the day of your presentation.
- > Posters must remain up the entire day. Do not remove posters before 16:00. Poster sessions are scheduled from 13:00 to 14:00.

> Presenters must be available for at least 1 hour between 13:00 and 14:00. After the session, please leave a note on your poster board as to where you can be reached in case someone wishes to discuss your research further.

#### Poster Removal

> Posters **must** be removed by 18:00 on the day of the presentation as there are **new posters each day** on the same board. Posters remaining after this time will be removed and disposed of every evening. The organizers will not be responsible for posters and materials left on poster boards after the stated hours.
